
- SLC has been selected for funding in the amount of \$36.7 million.

Anticipated Canyon Access Schedule*

- January 9 February 28
 - Roadway and unpaved trails will be closed to the public Monday-Friday beyond Site 16 (approx. 3 miles up the canyon).
- Roadway Closures Beginning May 2023
 - Due to high volume of use we anticipate that the roadway will be closed Monday-Friday during peak recreation times. This is to accommodate construction schedules and ensure the safety of the public.
 - The canyon is expected to remain open on the weekends and during holidays.
 - Specific closure information will be shared as it becomes available.
