On Wednesday, January 4, 2023, members of the CCWTP Upgrades Project team presented information to the Greater Avenues Community Council (GACC) regarding construction schedule updates, canyon access plans, BRIC funding details, and a preview of the architectural rendering for the new plant facilities.

The project team explained the accelerated schedule that comes with BRIC funding requirements, meaning:

- An overall quicker construction period
- Lower rates for SLCDPU customers
- Swift impacts to the existing plant over a shorter period of time

Details were also shared involving drinking water during construction. This project will create a pipeline on the existing CCWTP site to continue providing clean, delicious drinking water to surrounding communities.

Questions asked during the GACC Meeting included:

Q: Are there planned closures at Bonneville Blvd?

A: At this time, a partial closure from Site 16 and above (above 3 miles up the canyon) does not include Bonneville Blvd. Updates will be made known to the public in the event of a change.

Q: Will there be trees planted alongside the new facility?

A: There have not been previous plans for trees, but this suggestion has been brought to the project team for consideration, as the facility's contextual harmony with the surrounding canyon is one of the chief guiding design principles.

Q: Will roadway closures impact the Memory Grove Park area?

A: There are no planned impacts to the Memory Grove area within this project.
